	Summary: Laws concerning justice, fairness, and the firstfruits offering are
	given to encourage gratitude and faithful stewardship of the land.
П	Day 92: Deuteronomy 27-28
	Summary: Moses instructs the people to set up stones with the law written or
	them and pronounces blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience.
	Day 93: Deuteronomy 29-30
	Summary: The covenant is renewed in Moab. Moses calls the people to
	choose life by loving and obeying God.
	Day 94: Deuteronomy 31-32
	Summary: Moses hands leadership over to Joshua and teaches the people a
	song to remind them of God's faithfulness and warnings about future
	rebellion.
	Day 95: Deuteronomy 33-34
	Summary: Moses blesses the tribes of Israel before he dies. The book closes
	with the death of Moses and the appointment of Joshua.
	Day 96 : Joshua 1-2
	Summary: God commissions Joshua to lead Israel. Rahab hides the Israelite
	spies in Jericho, securing her family's safety during the coming conquest.
	Day 97: Joshua 3-4
	Summary: The Israelites cross the Jordan River on dry ground, and stones are
	set up as a memorial of God's deliverance.
	Day 98: Joshua 5-6
	Summary: Israel celebrates the Passover in the Promised Land. The walls of
	Jericho fall after the Israelites obey God's instructions







Day 99: Joshua 7-8
Summary: Israel suffers defeat at Ai due to Achan's sin. After dealing with the
sin, they conquer Ai.
Day 100 : Joshua 9-10
Summary: The Gibeonites deceive Israel into making a treaty. Joshua leads
Israel to victory in the southern campaign, with God miraculously extending
daylight.
Day 101 : Joshua 11-12
Summary: Joshua continues to lead the Israelites in conquering Canaan,
defeating the northern kings and summarizing the victories over 31 kings.
Day 102 : Joshua 13-14
Summary: The land east and west of the Jordan is divided among the tribes.
Caleb receives Hebron as his inheritance for his faithfulness.
Day 103: Joshua 15-17
Summary: The land is allocated to Judah, Ephraim, and Manasseh. Some tribes
fail to drive out all the inhabitants, leading to future trouble.
Day 104 : Joshua 18-19
Summary: The rest of the land is distributed among the remaining tribes,
including land for Benjamin, Simeon, Zebulun, and others.
Day 105 : Joshua 20-21
Summary: Cities of refuge are designated for those who accidentally kill
someone. The Levites are given cities among the other tribes.
Day 106 : Joshua 22
Summary: The eastern tribes return home after helping conquer the land. A
misunderstanding over an altar nearly leads to war, but peace is restored.

	Summary: Joshua gives his farewell address, urging the people to remain faithful to God. Israel renews its covenant with the Lord, and Joshua dies.
	Day 108: Judges 1-2 Summary: After Joshua's death, Israel struggles to fully drive out the Canaanites. The cycle of sin, oppression, and deliverance begins.
	Day 109: Judges 3-4 Summary: God raises up Othniel, Ehud, and Deborah as judges to deliver Israel from oppression after their repeated disobedience.
	Day 110: Judges 5-6 Summary: Deborah and Barak's song celebrates Israel's victory over Sisera. Gideon is called to deliver Israel from the Midianites.
	Day 111: Judges 7-8 Summary: Gideon defeats the Midianites with a small army. Later, Israel asks Gideon to be their king, but he refuses, and they soon turn back to idolatry.
	Day 112: Judges 9-10 Summary: Abimelech, Gideon's son, becomes a tyrant and is eventually killed. Israel again falls into idolatry, and God raises up new judges.
	Day 113: Judges 11-12 Summary: Jephthah leads Israel to victory over the Ammonites but makes a tragic vow. Minor judges, Ibzan, Elon, and Abdon, lead Israel after Jephthah.
	Day 114: Judges 13-14 Summary: The birth of Samson is announced by an angel. Samson grows up and begins to deliver Israel from the Philistines, but his weaknesses are evident







Day 115: Judges 15-16
Summary: Samson defeats the Philistines through various feats of strength but
ultimately is betrayed by Delilah and captured. He dies while bringing down a
Philistine temple.
Day 116: Judges 17-18
Summary: Micah's idolatry and the migration of the tribe of Dan illustrate the
spiritual decline of Israel during the time of the judges.
Day 117: Judges 19-21
Summary: A shocking story of violence in Israel leads to a civil war against the
tribe of Benjamin. The book ends with the refrain, "everyone did what was right
in his own eyes.
Day 118: Ruth 1-2
Summary: Naomi and Ruth return to Bethlehem, where Ruth gleans in the field
of Boaz, a relative of Naomi's late husband.
Day 119: Ruth 3-4
Summary: Ruth approaches Boaz as a potential redeemer. Boaz redeems Ruth
and marries her, and their descendants include King David.
Day 120: 1 Samuel 1-2
Summary: Hannah prays for a son, and God gives her Samuel. Samuel is
dedicated to the Lord's service, and Eli's wicked sons are condemned.
