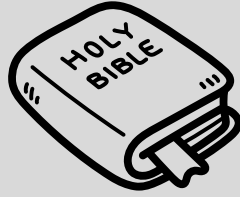

Monthly READING Plan

Month: January 1 - 31, 2025

Day 1: Genesis 1-2

Summary: The story of creation in six days, concluding with the Sabbath rest. God forms Adam and Eve as the first humans.

Day 2: Genesis 3-4

Summary: Adam and Eve's disobedience leads to the fall. Cain kills his brother Abel out of jealousy, and sin spreads in the world.

Day 3: Genesis 5-7

Summary: Noah is introduced, and God commands him to build the ark as judgment for humanity's wickedness approaches.

Day 4: Genesis 8-9

Summary: After the flood, Noah's family begins anew, and God makes a covenant with Noah, symbolized by the rainbow.

Day 5: Genesis 10-11

Summary: The table of nations is listed, followed by the story of the Tower of Babel, where God confuses languages.

Day 6: Genesis 12-13

Summary: God calls Abram to leave his homeland, promising to bless him. Abram and Lot separate due to their growing wealth.

Day 7: Genesis 14-15

Summary: Abram rescues Lot, and God establishes His covenant with Abram, promising countless descendants.

Day 8: Genesis 16-17

Summary: Sarai and Hagar's conflict over the birth of Ishmael. God reaffirms His covenant with Abram, changing his name to Abraham.

Monthly READING Plan

Month: January 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 9:** Genesis 18-19
Summary: God promises Sarah a son, Isaac. Sodom and Gomorrah are destroyed due to their wickedness, but Lot is spared.
- Day 10:** Genesis 20-21
Summary: Abraham and Abimelech. Isaac is born to Sarah, fulfilling God's promise, and Hagar and Ishmael are sent away.
- Day 11:** Genesis 22-23
Summary: God tests Abraham's faith by asking him to sacrifice Isaac. Sarah dies, and Abraham purchases land to bury her.
- Day 12:** Genesis 24-25
Summary: Rebekah becomes Isaac's wife. Abraham remarries and dies. Esau and Jacob, Isaac's sons, are born.
- Day 13:** Genesis 26
Summary: Isaac faces famine, makes a covenant with Abimelech, and God reaffirms the covenant He made with Abraham.
- Day 14:** Genesis 27-28
Summary: Jacob deceives Isaac and Esau, receiving the blessing. Jacob dreams of a ladder reaching heaven, and God speaks to him.
- Day 15:** Genesis 29-30
Summary: Jacob marries Leah and Rachel. His family grows as his wives bear him many children, the patriarchs of the tribes of Israel.
- Day 16:** Genesis 31-32
Summary: Jacob flees Laban and prepares to meet Esau, fearing revenge. He wrestles with an angel, receiving the name Israel.

Monthly READING Plan

Month: January 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 17:** Genesis 33-34
Summary: Jacob and Esau reconcile. Dinah, Jacob's daughter, is defiled, and her brothers seek revenge.
- Day 18:** Genesis 35-36
Summary: Jacob returns to Bethel. Esau's descendants are listed, and Isaac dies.
- Day 19:** Genesis 37-38
Summary: Joseph is sold into slavery by his jealous brothers. Judah's family troubles unfold.
- Day 20:** Genesis 39-40
Summary: Joseph, as a slave, gains favor in Potiphar's house but is wrongly imprisoned. God continues to be with Joseph in prison.
- Day 21:** Genesis 41-42
Summary: Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dreams, becoming second in command in Egypt. His brothers visit Egypt for grain during the famine.
- Day 22:** Genesis 43-44
Summary: Joseph's brothers return to Egypt, this time with Benjamin. Joseph tests them to see if they have changed.
- Day 23:** Genesis 45-46
Summary: Joseph reveals himself to his brothers and brings his family to Egypt.
- Day 24:** Genesis 47-48
Summary: Joseph manages Egypt's resources during the famine. Jacob blesses Joseph's sons.

Monthly READING Plan

Month: January 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 25:** Genesis 49-50
Summary: Jacob blesses his sons and dies. Joseph forgives his brothers, reaffirming God's providence.
- Day 26:** Exodus 1-2
Summary: The Israelites are enslaved in Egypt. Moses is born and flees to Midian after killing an Egyptian.
- Day 27:** Exodus 3-4
Summary: God calls Moses from the burning bush to lead Israel out of Egypt, equipping him with signs and Aaron as his spokesperson.
- Day 28:** Exodus 5-6
Summary: Moses confronts Pharaoh, but Pharaoh increases the Israelites' burdens. God promises deliverance.
- Day 29:** Exodus 7-8
Summary: The first plagues—blood and frogs—afflict Egypt as Pharaoh refuses to let the Israelites go.
- Day 30:** Exodus 9-10
Summary: The plagues of boils, hail, locusts, and darkness further harden Pharaoh's heart.
- Day 31:** Exodus 11-12
Summary: The final plague, the death of the firstborn, is announced. The Passover is instituted as a memorial, and Pharaoh finally releases the Israelites.
