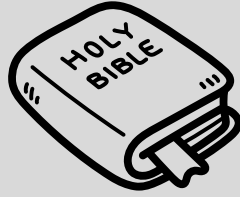

Monthly READING Plan

Month: March 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 60:** Numbers 1-2
Summary: A census is taken of the Israelites, and the organization of the camp is established as they prepare to journey through the wilderness.
- Day 61:** Numbers 3-4
Summary: The duties of the Levites are assigned, with specific roles for the clans of Kohath, Gershon, and Merari in caring for the Tabernacle.
- Day 62:** Numbers 5-6
Summary: Laws for purity, restitution, and the test for unfaithfulness are given. The Nazirite vow is explained, and the priestly blessing is introduced.
- Day 63:** Numbers 7
Summary: The leaders of Israel bring offerings for the dedication of the altar over the span of twelve days.
- Day 64:** Numbers 8-9
Summary: The Levites are consecrated for their service in the Tabernacle. Instructions for observing the Passover are reiterated.
- Day 65:** Numbers 10-11
Summary: The Israelites begin their journey from Sinai. They complain about the lack of meat, and God sends quail but also a plague.
- Day 66:** Numbers 12-13
Summary: Miriam and Aaron speak against Moses, and Miriam is struck with leprosy. Spies are sent to explore Canaan, but only Joshua and Caleb give a positive report.
- Day 67:** Numbers 14-15
Summary: The people rebel and refuse to enter Canaan, leading to God's judgment of forty years of wandering. Instructions for offerings are given.

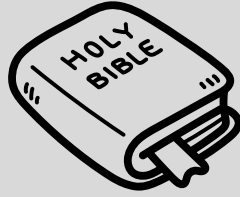
Monthly READING Plan

Month: March 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 68:** Numbers 16-17
Summary: Korah leads a rebellion against Moses and Aaron, but God judges the rebels. Aaron's staff buds as a sign of his authority.
- Day 69:** Numbers 18-19
Summary: The duties and privileges of the priests and Levites are reaffirmed. The law of purification using the ashes of a red heifer is introduced.
- Day 70:** Numbers 20-21
Summary: Moses strikes the rock to bring water, but disobeys God, leading to his punishment. The Israelites begin conquering the land of Canaan, defeating several kings.
- Day 71:** Numbers 22-23
Summary: Balaam is summoned by King Balak to curse Israel, but God intervenes. Balaam's donkey speaks, and Balaam blesses Israel instead of cursing them.
- Day 72:** Numbers 24-25
Summary: Balaam continues to bless Israel. Israel later falls into idolatry and immorality, leading to a plague that is stopped by Phinehas' zealous action.
- Day 73:** Numbers 26-27
Summary: A second census is taken as Israel prepares to enter the Promised Land. The daughters of Zelophehad request their inheritance rights, and Joshua is appointed as Moses' successor.
- Day 74:** Numbers 28-29
Summary: God outlines the daily, weekly, and festival offerings that the Israelites are to bring throughout the year, emphasizing their continual worship.

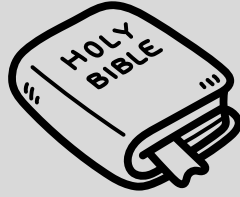
Monthly READING Plan

Month: March 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 75:** Numbers 30-31
Summary: Vows are regulated, especially concerning women. Israel defeats the Midianites as part of God's judgment against them for leading Israel into sin.
- Day 76:** Numbers 32-33
Summary: The tribes of Reuben and Gad request to settle east of the Jordan River. The journey from Egypt to the plains of Moab is reviewed.
- Day 77:** Numbers 34-35
Summary: God defines the borders of the Promised Land and appoints cities of refuge for those guilty of accidental manslaughter.
- Day 78:** Numbers 36
Summary: The inheritance laws concerning the daughters of Zelophehad are clarified, ensuring their land stays within their tribe.
- Day 79:** Deuteronomy 1-2
Summary: Moses begins his farewell address to Israel, recounting their journey from Mount Sinai to the edge of the Promised Land.
- Day 80:** Deuteronomy 3-4
Summary: Moses recounts Israel's victories over the kings of Og and Sihon. He emphasizes obedience to God's law as the Israelites prepare to enter Canaan.
- Day 81:** Deuteronomy 5-6
Summary: Moses reviews the Ten Commandments and calls Israel to love God wholeheartedly, reminding them of the Shema: "The LORD our God is one LORD."
- Day 82:** Deuteronomy 7-8
Summary: Moses urges Israel to remain faithful to God, promising victory over their enemies and reminding them not to forget God's blessings.

- Day 83:** Deuteronomy 9-10
Summary: Moses recounts the story of the golden calf, emphasizing God's mercy and the renewal of the covenant after Israel's rebellion.
- Day 84:** Deuteronomy 11-12
Summary: Moses calls for wholehearted obedience to God and describes the blessings of obedience and the curses of disobedience.
- Day 85:** Deuteronomy 13-14
Summary: Instructions are given to avoid idolatry and to distinguish clean from unclean animals, reinforcing Israel's unique identity.
- Day 86:** Deuteronomy 15-16
Summary: The laws of debt cancellation, generosity, and the festivals of Passover, Pentecost, and Tabernacles are outlined
- Day 87:** Deuteronomy 17-18
Summary: Guidelines for justice, the appointment of kings, and the roles of priests and prophets are given to ensure Israel follows God's laws.
- Day 88:** Deuteronomy 19-20
Summary: Laws about cities of refuge, witnesses, and warfare are introduced, emphasizing justice and mercy in Israel's society
- Day 89:** Deuteronomy 21-22
Summary: Laws concerning family, marriage, and justice are given to promote a just and compassionate society in Israel.
- Day 90:** Deuteronomy 23-24
Summary: Additional laws about holiness, marriage, and social justice are given, emphasizing compassion for the poor and vulnerable.
