



Day 121: 1 Samuel 3-4
Summary: God calls Samuel as a prophet. The Philistines capture the Ark of the
Covenant, and Eli's sons die in battle.
Day 122: 1 Samuel 5-6
<i>Summary</i> : The Philistines suffer plagues because of the Ark, and they return it to
Israel with offerings to appease God.
Day 123: 1 Samuel 7-8
<i>Summary</i> : Samuel leads Israel to victory over the Philistines. Later, the people
demand a king, despite Samuel's warnings.
Day 124: 1 Samuel 9-10
<i>Summary</i> : Saul is chosen as Israel's first king, anointed by Samuel, and
proclaimed king by the people.
Day 125: 1 Samuel 11-12
<i>Summary</i> : Saul leads Israel to victory over the Ammonites. Samuel gives his
farewell speech, reminding Israel of their covenant with God.
Day 126: 1 Samuel 13-14
<i>Summary</i> : Saul disobeys God, leading to the announcement that his dynasty will
not last. Jonathan, Saul's son, wins a great victory over the Philistines
Day 127: 1 Samuel 15-16
<i>Summary</i> : Saul disobeys God again, leading to his rejection as king. Samuel
anoints David, a shepherd, as the next king of Israel.
Day 128: 1 Samuel 17-18
<i>Summary</i> : David defeats Goliath, becoming a hero in Israel. Saul becomes
jealous of David's popularity.



	Summary: David flees from Saul and gathers a group of followers. Saul kills the
	priests of Nob for helping David.
П	Day 131 : 1 Samuel 23-24
	Summary: David spares Saul's life in a cave, showing mercy despite being
	pursued by Saul.
П	Day 132 : 1 Samuel 25-26
	Summary: David marries Abigail after her wise intervention. Later, David again
	spares Saul's life when he sneaks into his camp.
	Day 133 : 1 Samuel 27-28
	Summary: David lives among the Philistines to avoid Saul. Saul seeks counsel
	from a medium, violating God's commands.
	Day 134 : 1 Samuel 29-31
	<i>Summary</i> : The Philistines reject David from joining their battle. Saul and his sons
	die in battle against the Philistines.
	Day 135 : 2 Samuel 1-2
	Summary: David mourns Saul and Jonathan's death and is anointed king of
	Judah. A civil war begins between David's house and Saul's.
	Day 136 : 2 Samuel 3-4
	<i>Summary</i> : David grows stronger as king, while Saul's house weakens.
	Ishbosheth, Saul's son, is murdered.











Day 145: 2 Samuel 21-22
Summary: David deals with a famine and battles the Philistines again. He sings a
song of deliverance, praising God for His protection and faithfulness.
Day 146: 2 Samuel 23-24
Summary: David's final words highlight God's covenant with him. He takes a
census of Israel, which angers God, leading to a plague that is stopped by
David's sacrifice.
Day 147: 1 Kings 1-2
Summary: David's son Adonijah attempts to take the throne, but Solomon is
anointed king. David gives final instructions before his death, and Solomon
establishes his rule.
Day 148: 1 Kings 3-4
Summary: Solomon asks God for wisdom, and his request is granted.
Solomon's wisdom becomes renowned, and Israel prospers under his reign.
Day 149: 1 Kings 5-6
Summary: Solomon prepares to build the temple, and construction begins. The
details of the temple's design and structure are described.
Day 150 : 1 Kings 7-8
<i>Summary</i> : Solomon completes the temple and his royal palace. The Ark of the
Covenant is brought to the temple, and Solomon prays at the dedication
Day 151 : 1 Kings 9-10
Summary: God appears to Solomon, promising blessings for obedience and
warnings for disobedience. Solomon's wealth and fame grow, and he is visited
by the Queen of Sheba.
