# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** August 1 - 31, 2025

**Day 213:** Nehemiah 7-8

*Summary:* Nehemiah organizes the people and records those who returned from exile. Ezra reads the Law to the people, and they celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles.

**Day 214:** Nehemiah 9-10

*Summary:* The people confess their sins and renew the covenant with God, committing to follow His laws and avoid intermarrying with foreign nations.

**Day 215:** Nehemiah 11-12

*Summary:* The leaders and people settle in Jerusalem and other cities. The dedication of the wall of Jerusalem is celebrated with great joy and worship.

**Day 216:** Nehemiah 13

*Summary:* Nehemiah returns to Jerusalem and enforces the covenant, confronting issues like Sabbath-breaking, intermarriage, and neglect of temple duties.

**Day 217:** Esther 1-2

*Summary:* Queen Vashti is deposed, and Esther, a Jewish woman, is chosen to be the new queen of Persia. Mordecai, her cousin, uncovers a plot against the king.

**Day 218:** Esther 3-4

*Summary:* Haman, an official, plots to destroy the Jews. Mordecai urges Esther to intervene, risking her life by approaching the king without being summoned.

**Day 219:** Esther 5-6

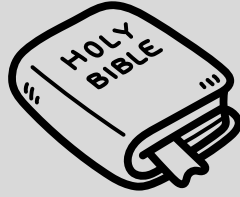
*Summary:* Esther invites the king and Haman to a banquet. Meanwhile, the king honors Mordecai for saving his life, and Haman's plot against Mordecai begins to unravel.

**Day 220:** Esther 7-8

*Summary:* Esther reveals Haman's plot to destroy the Jews, and Haman is executed. The king allows the Jews to defend themselves from their enemies.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** August 1 - 31, 2025

**Day 221:** Esther 9-10

*Summary:* The Jews defeat their enemies, and the feast of Purim is established to celebrate their deliverance. The book ends with the exaltation of Mordecai.

**Day 222:** Job 1-2

*Summary:* Job, a righteous man, experiences great suffering as Satan tests his faith. Job loses his wealth, children, and health, but he remains faithful to God.

**Day 223:** Job 3-4

*Summary:* Job laments his birth and curses the day he was born. Eliphaz, one of Job's friends, suggests that Job's suffering is due to his sin.

**Day 224:** Job 5-7

*Summary:* Eliphaz continues, emphasizing God's correction. Job responds with anguish, questioning why he suffers and expressing his deep sorrow.

**Day 225:** Job 8-10

*Summary:* Bildad, another friend, argues that Job's children died because of their sin. Job maintains his innocence and pleads for an audience with God.

**Day 226:** Job 11-13

*Summary:* Zophar, the third friend, accuses Job of deserving worse than he has suffered. Job insists on his integrity and desires to present his case before God.

**Day 227:** Job 14-16

*Summary:* Job reflects on the brevity and difficulty of life. Eliphaz accuses Job of speaking against God, and Job responds by lamenting his friends' lack of compassion.

**Day 228:** Job 17-19

*Summary:* Job continues to express his despair and feels abandoned by everyone. Bildad suggests Job is wicked, but Job clings to the hope of seeing his Redeemer.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** August 1 - 31, 2025

- Day 229:** Job 20-21  
*Summary:* Zophar asserts that the wicked always face judgment. Job counters, pointing out that the wicked often prosper in life, even without facing judgment.
- Day 230:** Job 22-24  
*Summary:* Eliphaz accuses Job of various sins. Job responds by declaring his longing for God's justice and lamenting the apparent prosperity of the wicked.
- Day 231:** Job 25-28  
*Summary:* Bildad briefly speaks about God's majesty. Job answers with a reflection on human wisdom and the fear of the Lord as the source of true wisdom.
- Day 232:** Job 29-31  
*Summary:* Job recalls his former life of respect and prosperity. He reaffirms his integrity and lists the ways in which he has sought to live righteously.
- Day 233:** Job 32-34  
*Summary:* Elihu, a younger man, speaks up, criticizing both Job and his friends. He defends God's justice and suggests that suffering can be a way of refining people.
- Day 234:** Job 35-37  
*Summary:* Elihu continues, emphasizing God's greatness and sovereignty. He points out that God's ways are beyond human understanding.
- Day 235:** Job 38-39  
*Summary:* God speaks to Job out of a whirlwind, questioning him about the mysteries of creation and demonstrating the vastness of His power and wisdom.
- Day 236:** Job 40-42  
*Summary:* God challenges Job's questioning of His justice. Job humbles himself before God, who then restores Job's fortunes and blesses him more than before.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** August 1 - 31, 2025

**Day 237:** Psalm 1-4

*Summary:* The Psalms open with reflections on the blessedness of the righteous, the trustworthiness of God, and prayers for protection from enemies.

**Day 238:** Psalm 5-8

*Summary:* David prays for guidance and deliverance, praises God's majesty, and marvels at the care God has for humanity.

**Day 239:** Psalm 9-12

*Summary:* David expresses confidence in God's judgment, laments the wickedness in the world, and prays for justice and protection.

**Day 240:** Psalm 13-16

*Summary:* David pleads for God's deliverance and declares his trust in God's faithful love and protection. He also rejoices in God's presence and eternal life.

**Day 241:** Psalm 17-20

*Summary:* David seeks refuge in God, asking for vindication and deliverance from his enemies. He praises God for His strength and blessings.

**Day 242:** Psalm 21-24

*Summary:* David thanks God for victories and deliverance, reflects on the Good Shepherd's care, and celebrates the King of glory's entry.

**Day 243:** Psalm 25-28

*Summary:* David prays for forgiveness, guidance, and deliverance. He trusts in God's protection and pleads for His mercy.
