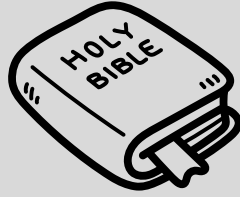

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** June 1 - 30, 2025

- Day 152:** 1 Kings 11-12  
*Summary:* Solomon turns away from God by marrying foreign wives and worshiping their gods. After his death, the kingdom is divided between Rehoboam and Jeroboam.
- Day 153:** 1 Kings 13-14  
*Summary:* A prophet delivers a warning to Jeroboam, but he refuses to repent. The kingdom faces judgment, and both Jeroboam's and Rehoboam's reigns are troubled.
- Day 154:** 1 Kings 15-16  
*Summary:* Several kings rise and fall in both Israel and Judah, with most turning away from God. The political and spiritual state of the divided kingdom deteriorates.
- Day 155:** 1 Kings 17-18  
*Summary:* The prophet Elijah begins his ministry by declaring a drought. He later confronts the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel, demonstrating the power of God.
- Day 156:** 1 Kings 19-20  
*Summary:* Elijah flees from Jezebel's threats and encounters God in a gentle whisper. Meanwhile, King Ahab battles the Syrians and receives God's help.
- Day 157:** 1 Kings 21-22  
*Summary:* King Ahab's greed leads to the murder of Naboth for his vineyard. Later, Ahab is killed in battle, fulfilling a prophecy of his downfall.
- Day 158:** 2 Kings 1-2  
*Summary:* Elijah is taken up to heaven in a whirlwind, and Elisha takes over his prophetic ministry. Elisha immediately begins performing miracles.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** June 1 - 30, 2025

- Day 159:** 2 Kings 3-4  
*Summary:* Elisha aids the kings of Israel, Judah, and Edom in their war against Moab. He also performs miracles, including providing oil for a widow and raising a boy from the dead.
- Day 160:** 2 Kings 5-6  
*Summary:* Elisha heals Naaman, a Syrian commander, of leprosy. Later, Elisha's prophetic insight helps Israel in its battles, and he miraculously provides food during a famine.
- Day 161:** 2 Kings 7-8  
*Summary:* Elisha prophesies the end of a siege, and Israel is miraculously delivered. Later, the political struggles in Israel and Judah continue.
- Day 162:** 2 Kings 9-10  
*Summary:* Jehu is anointed king of Israel and carries out God's judgment on the house of Ahab, including the deaths of Jezebel and Ahab's descendants.
- Day 163:** 2 Kings 11-12  
*Summary:* Joash becomes king of Judah as a child and repairs the temple. Under his reign, Judah returns to worshipping God, but idolatry persists.
- Day 164:** 2 Kings 13-14  
*Summary:* The kings of Israel and Judah continue to face internal and external challenges. Elisha dies, but even in death, he performs a final miracle.
- Day 165:** 2 Kings 15-16  
*Summary:* The kings of Israel and Judah rise and fall, with most continuing in idolatry. Israel faces increasing pressure from Assyria.
- Day 166:** 2 Kings 17-18  
*Summary:* The northern kingdom of Israel falls to Assyria due to its persistent idolatry. In contrast, King Hezekiah of Judah trusts in God and reforms worship.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** June 1 - 30, 2025

- Day 167:** 2 Kings 19-20  
*Summary:* Hezekiah seeks God's help when Judah is threatened by Assyria, and God miraculously delivers them. Later, Hezekiah falls ill but is healed by God.
- Day 168:** 2 Kings 21-22  
*Summary:* Manasseh, Hezekiah's son, leads Judah into great wickedness. Later, Josiah becomes king and begins a major religious reform after discovering the Book of the Law.
- Day 169:** 2 Kings 23-24  
*Summary:* Josiah restores true worship in Judah but is eventually killed in battle. After his death, Judah's decline accelerates, leading to its eventual downfall.
- Day 170:** 2 Kings 25  
*Summary:* Jerusalem is besieged and destroyed by the Babylonians. The people of Judah are taken into exile, marking the end of the kingdom of Judah.
- Day 171:** 1 Chronicles 1-2  
*Summary:* The genealogies from Adam to Israel (Jacob) are recounted, focusing on the descendants of Abraham and Isaac.
- Day 172:** 1 Chronicles 3-4  
*Summary:* The genealogies continue, listing the descendants of David and the tribes of Judah and Simeon.
- Day 173:** 1 Chronicles 5-6  
*Summary:* The genealogies of the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and Levi are detailed, emphasizing the priestly duties of the Levites.
- Day 174:** 1 Chronicles 7-8  
*Summary:* The genealogies of the remaining tribes, including Issachar, Benjamin, and Ephraim, are recorded.

# Monthly READING Plan

**Month:** June 1 - 30, 2025

- Day 175:** 1 Chronicles 9-10  
*Summary:* The genealogies conclude with a focus on the returned exiles. The death of Saul and his sons is recounted, marking the transition to David's reign.
- Day 176:** 1 Chronicles 11-12  
*Summary:* David becomes king and conquers Jerusalem. His mighty men and the armies that supported him are listed, showcasing his rise to power.
- Day 177:** 1 Chronicles 13-14  
*Summary:* David attempts to bring the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem, but Uzzah dies for touching it. David later succeeds and defeats the Philistines.
- Day 178:** 1 Chronicles 15-16  
*Summary:* The Ark is brought into Jerusalem with great celebration. David appoints Levites to lead worship and offers a psalm of thanksgiving to God.
- Day 179:** 1 Chronicles 17-18  
*Summary:* God makes a covenant with David, promising that his descendants will reign forever. David's victories over his enemies are recounted.
- Day 180:** 1 Chronicles 19-20  
*Summary:* David defeats the Ammonites and their allies. More victories over the Philistines are recorded, including battles against giants.
- Day 181:** 1 Chronicles 21-22  
*Summary:* David sins by taking a census, resulting in a plague. He buys the threshing floor of Araunah, where the future temple will be built. David makes preparations for the temple.
